Interfor's **Millwright Accelerator Training** is for experienced maintenance employees who have demonstrated the ability to perform essential job functions of a Millwright and want to upgrade their skills and career with a lesser time commitment than the Millwright Apprenticeship Program. If you want to increase your skills and grow your career at Interfor, this might be the value-building opportunity for you.

Unleash your potential

Interfor provides a framework that lets you master your career; advance your knowledge, skills, and performance; earn better wages; and enjoy long-term employment.

How the program works

The Millwright Accelerator Training consists of three levels. Each level of training is comprised of five virtual classrooms followed by a 5-day, hands-on workshop. We accept up to 12 participants for each cohort.

While taking part in this training, you can expect to participate in a 1-hour virtual classroom each week. You will also be expected to complete all the required reading and submit assignments online. Following the virtual classrooms, you will attend a practical hands-on workshop held at the Trades Center for Excellence in Perry, GA, which will take place for five full days along with other participants from various mills. An assessment will be administered at the end of the workshop. Travel and meal accommodations are provided if necessary.

Applicant selection process

Millwright Accelerator Training will be announced through internal job postings. If you would like to apply, please contact your Human Resources representative or Supervisor to complete an online application.

All applicants must meet the following **minimum requirements**:

- » Be a maintenance employee with several years of millwright experience
- » Have the physical capability to perform essential trade tasks, including lifting up to 50 lbs
- » Be able to demonstrate learned skills in regular assessments
- » Be able to travel overnight to attend a 5-day practical workshop in Perry, Georgia

Applicants who meet the minimum requirements will enter the following application process:

- 3 Interview with Local Mill Leadership**
