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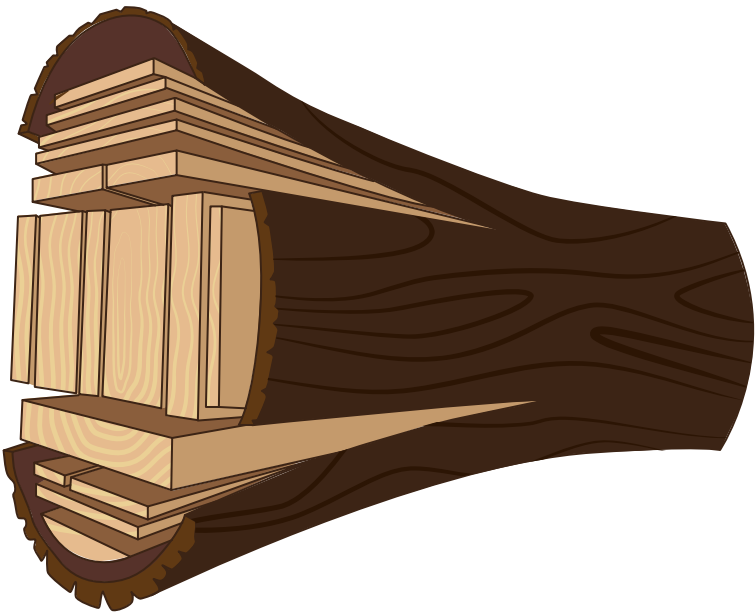
SAWMILL OPERATIONS TRAINEE PROGRAM

BECOME TOMORROW’S SAWMILL LEADER

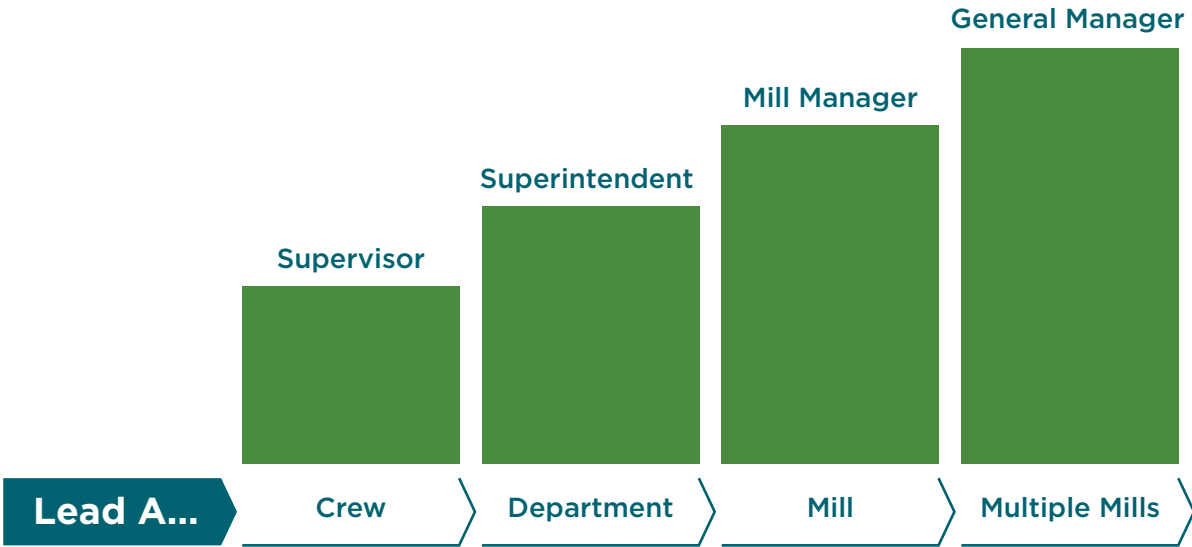
Through our Sawmill Operations Trainee Program, we are developing new employees’ industry knowledge and technical understanding of sawmilling to develop our future sawmill leaders.

The program includes one year of formal learning through the British Columbia Institute of Technology (BCIT) combined with practical hands-on experience supported by mentorship at one of Interfor’s sawmill operations.

Upon completion of the year, you will have earned an Associate Certificate in Wood Processing from an accredited educational institution recognized across North America.

BEGIN JOB IN THE SAWMILL

You will get the basics from log to lumber to gain knowledge of the full process from the forest to mill and out to market.

Understanding the basic understandings of the mechanical functions of the primary and secondary breakdown, and all the machine centers throughout the manufacturing process of the lumber.

Firsthand experience with the saw filing process, maintenance planning, and real time maintenance activities that are key to the overall operation of the sawmill.

Learning and observing the QC in the planer and sawmill, including the importance of grading and the finished product expectations.

Understanding the boiler and kiln operations and taking what you have learned throughout the course and applying that to the supervisory basics and beginning to lead.
